Course Description:

In the course, Play Therapy Seminar, participants will examine play therapy techniques for use with a variety of populations. Participants will reflect on their own practice of play therapy and develop appropriate therapeutic interventions for children. This course will include:

- * lecture
- * demonstration
- * hands-on experience with a variety of techniques and modalities
- * course readings
- * and written assignments.

Participants will be required to complete a final project that will reflect best practice of play therapy as it applies to their current counseling setting. This course is designed for practicing school counselors, clinical therapists, child development specialists and graduate interns in counseling.
